### How to Join the Library

Anyone who lives in the Jericho Union Free School District may become a library member. A photo identification and a second identification indicating home address are required (driver's license, utility bill, etc.). You may check out three books until the Library card is received in the mail. A yellow Preschool Program Registration card will be given to children from birth to 4 years of age. Children may have a library card when they are five years old. The child must be accompanied by a parent who shows the correct identification and proof of the child's age.
