

Libby: e-Books for Your Kindle

Kindle, Kindle Paperwhite, Kindle Oasis*

*Note: These instructions will work for any Kindle with a black-and-white screen.
Use the OverDrive App instructions for the Kindle Fire or Amazon Fire.*

Log In to Your Amazon Account on Your Device:

From your browser, go to www.amazon.com and sign in to your account. You must have your Amazon login and password to proceed. Your Kindle must also be registered on your Amazon account.

Install the Libby App on Your Device (one time only):

1. Go to the App Store (iOS) or Play Store (Android) on your device.
2. Download and install the free *Libby, by OverDrive* app.
3. Open the Libby app. Under *Do you have a library card?* Touch YES
4. Touch I'll Search For A Library. Search for Jericho Public Library
5. Select Jericho Public Library
6. Select Sign in With My Card. Then select Jericho Public Library
7. Touch Next. You will be re-directed to sign in at the Jericho Public Library's website. iOS users: Touch Continue under the pop-up window that reads: "Libby" wants to use "overdrive.com" to sign in.
8. Log in with our Jericho Public Library barcode and PIN.
9. Touch Next.

Search for and Download e-Books & e-Audiobooks via the Libby App:

1. Search for a title or author using the magnifying glass (bottom left corner) or go to the eLibrary to browse new, popular or available materials.
2. Select a title and touch Borrow.
3. On the next screen, choose the time period to borrow the item (default is 21 days) and click the red Borrow! button.
4. Touch Open Book. On the next screen, select Kindle.
5. You will be redirected to Amazon.com which will display your chosen title. Be sure you are selecting the correct Kindle (if your household has multiple Kindles). Select Deliver to [Your Kindle's name].
6. Touch Get Library Book.
7. Your book will download to your Kindle the next time the device syncs. Make sure your Kindle is set to Wi-Fi for syncing.
8. After the sync, the title will appear at the top of the list of books on your Kindle.
9. Touch the book title on your Kindle to open the book and start reading!
