

SALE OF EXHIBITS AND BOOKS POLICY

It is the policy of the Board of Trustees of the Jericho Public Library not to have the Library or any of its staff members participate in, or promote the sale of exhibits or books by lecturers. On occasion, however, at the discretion of the Director, the Library will allow a price list of exhibits to be prepared by the exhibitor and be available to patrons. Similarly, at the discretion of the Director, an author may be permitted to sell his/her books to attendees at the close of his/her lecture. Whenever exhibits are presented for sale the Jericho Public Library shall not act as sales agent. All sales are to be made directly between the exhibitor, or his agents.

Arrangements for the sale of items must be made with the Director in advance of the exhibit or lecture.

The price charged for exhibits or books shall be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor, author/publisher or purchaser. The Jericho Public Library will not assume any liability, financial or otherwise, for the sale of exhibits or books.
